2.09– Research and implement a student to student peer mentorship program for African American students

## Narrative

For the 2020-2021 school year, all faculty and staff will be trained in Kids at HOPE, a belief system where all students feel capable of success and everyone understands all students are capable of success. With this program, the faculty and staff will create a "Shark Buddies" peer mentorship program through our Positive Learning Environment (PLE) committee through our Positive Behavior Intervention Support (PBIS) systems. Not only will we continue to promote social emotional learning and target specific traits like empathy and compassion, but our mentoring program will empower student leaders to build others.

During the 2019-2020 school year, we had a partnership with Vero Beach High School's STAR program. A VBHS senior organized 12 high school students to visit our campus weekly for 45 minutes to talk with an elementary student. The students were selected by teachers/administrators. Parent permission slips were sent home (see next page). We hope to continue this program next year, if the club/program is still available.
