Reflection:

Fellsmere visited VBE on October 13. A Math coach and 2 teachers (one from 4th and one from 5th) went for a half day to be immersed in their planning and teaching. FES has already made changes to 4th/5th grade planning based on visit. Follow up in instruction is beginning soon.
