Our Guidance department has looked at the schedules of students in all of our minority subgroups to determine which students could be exposed to a more rigorous schedule of classes. These classes include advanced, AP, Pre-IB, IB, Dual Enrollment, CTE, etc. Teacher recommendations have assisted guidance in placement and students are being closely monitored. Assistance, tutoring, and remediation are given through in-class and after-school opportunities in order to ensure these students are successful. In addition to this, our school has created a School Choice video to highlight many of our school's offerings to engage students and families in the many possibilities that SRHS has to offer.

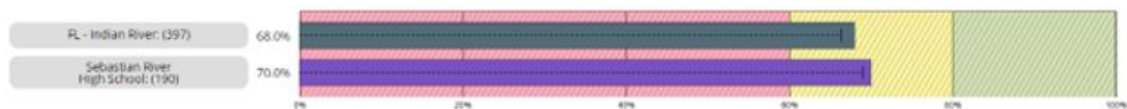
**Results of Action

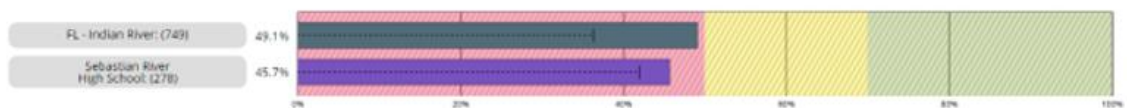

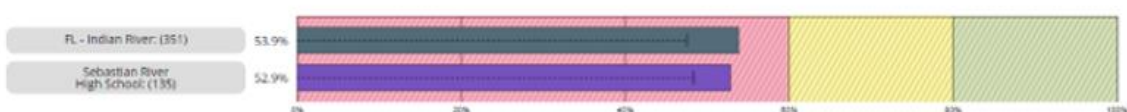

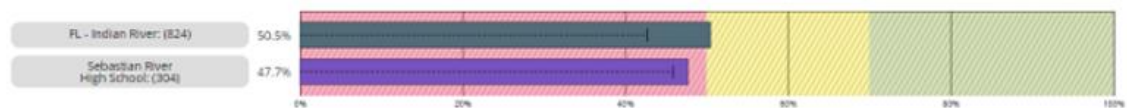
