Cheerleading incorporated activities that focus on enhancing feelings of competence, self- determination, and skills development during cheerleading intramurals prior to tryouts. The cheerleaders took part in a district-wide cheer camp open to high school and middle school cheerleaders over the summer. The cheerleading repertoire has been modified by adjusting the complexity of tumbling requirements preferred for Varsity to be a standing back- handspring (a minimal tumbling skill) which was previously a back tuck. Students also can learn these skills on the Junior Varsity level so they can excel to Varsity. The Cheer Team has developed a "Sponsorship Program" available for individuals who have financial burdens to help defray costs for camp, uniforms and private tumbling coaches.
Results of Action	Due to COVID 19 cheer tryouts were held virtually. 23 Cheerleaders were selected, 3 were African American.

- 19. Age Limit Rule A student who reaches the age of 19 on or after September 1, and who has not exceeded his/her four-year limit of eligibility, may participate in interscholastic athletics during that school year.
