Explanation of Evidence:

Teachers have access to real-time data for African American students through FOCUS. Monthly department chair meetings will incorporate discussions of data and plans will be developed for targeted improvement. An example of baseline data generated through FOCUS has been uploaded (A.A. Baseline Data for FSA ELA). This data will be utilized in an English Language Arts Department meeting scheduled for 10/09. Data like this will be utilized in department meetings throughout the year. Teachers are required to provide formative assessments and tailor instruction based on that data, which they review in department meetings. Teachers have been trained on a new instrument for administering formative assessments and collecting data called iReady. Training for utilizing the iReady platform took place on 09/30/2020 (iReady Training Email). The first administration of formative assessments administered through iReady is scheduled for 10/07/20 (iReady Sessions 10-07-20).

Results of Action Taken:


Teachers will collect formative data throughout the school year with the new platform, iReady. Baseline data and formative date for African American students will be reviewed in monthly department meetings to target areas for improvement and create action plans.

Reflection:

The iReady tool will make the process of collecting data and utilizing it to modify instruction more accessible for teachers. The continued practice of data chats during department meetings will help ensure that African American student achievement remains an area of focus for the school.
