Results of Action Taken:	Coaches will be training teachers the week of October 5th to access their student performance data in order to begin tracking students who are low performing and need extra assistance with special emphasis on AA Students.
Reflection:	This process of data tracking and data meetings will be departmental and facilitated monthly by our math and literacy coaches.
