1.15 High school instructional staff and administrators will identify the specific standards from Unit Assessments in English, Mathematics, Biology, and U.S. History by race to support schools in identifying course concepts / standards that need to be re-taught to improve mastery for African American students and reduce the likelihood of course failures.

**Explanation of Evidence:**

Several processes are in place to collect data in order to monitor the progress of AA Students. Data chats are scheduled to begin in October which will follow our initial benchmark assessments in core subject areas. In addition to these, several other data processes will begin implementation in October:

- Quarterly Impact Review Action Plans
- Common planning sessions
- Instructional Coach facilitating
- Data Chats
- Quarterly Classroom walk through
- Documented support of interventions and strategies provided to teachers from principals

**Results of Action Taken:**

Coaches will be training teachers the week of October 5th to access their student performance data in order to begin tracking students who are low performing and need extra assistance with special emphasis on AA Students.

**Reflection:**

This process of data tracking and data meetings will be departmental and facilitated monthly by our math and literacy coaches.
