Students will be recommended by fifth grade teachers for advanced courses. At this time, students who are identified as gifted and/or performing above grade level will be provided enrichment opportunities.

Reflection:

Due to COVID-19, three of our gifted teachers are teaching remotely. All students who are identified as gifted have been enrolled into a gifted course through CANVAS. Gifted endorsed teachers (on campus) collaboratively plan with their grade levels to enrich curriculum and share plans. Gifted endorsed teachers are across all grade levels 1-5.
