
10/20/20 There are currently 38 Option 1 seniors that need a math concordant score. The PERT test will be administered on Tuesday 1/20 after a 1 hour bootcamp session. Personal invitations were sent to all 38 students. 9/21/20SAT School Day will be given at Vero Beach High School on October 14th, 2020. This test is for Seniors only that have not met their FSA and/or math requirement for graduation. Students will be notified about the test through their FOCUS messenger, and SDIRC email. This will ensure that students on Options 2 and 3 have the opportunity to come on campus to test. Parents will also receive notification on the parent FOCUS. VBHS will also post testing information on the VBHS website, under "Students and Families" tab, then "Testing Information" VBHS also communicates via phone message to parents. 11/18/20: Students are actively being registered for the SAT/ACT by the graduation coach, the next weekend administration (non-school day) will be Dec. 5th. PERT continues to be used for seniors that need their math concordant score.

Results of Action Taken:

Using FOCUS and EMAIL, students will that are on option 2 and 3 will be able to register online to test, providing access to all students.

Reflection:

The process for online registration using email and FOCUS was tested during the FSA RETAKE window Sept 14 – Oct. 21. Students enrolled in options 2 and 3 were able to register online and come on campus to test. The communication was successful and achieved the desired result of providing access to testing for all students.
