measurable data.)** Eighteen school-based staff members participated in Youth Mental Health First Aid (YMHFA) certification training on November 7, 2020. YMHFA is a 6-hour training that provides a 3-year certification. All participants passed the required post-test and provided favorable feedback regarding the training.

**Results of Action
Taken:** Trauma-informed care training and staff development is ongoing, and implementation will be monitored as training is completed. The next relevant training, "Trauma Informed Practices to Promote Student Success," is scheduled for Dec 1, 2020, for secondary school counselors and Dec 3, 2020, for elementary school counselors.

Reflection: Trauma-informed care training is critical given the environmental stressors students and staff are experiencing in 2020.

6403003: Youth Mental Health and First Aid Training

(Minimum of 5 participants required) Youth Mental Health First Aid is a state-mandated training (all school-based personnel must complete this course) designed to teach parents, family members, caregivers, teachers, school staff, peers, neighbors, health and human services workers, and other caring citizens how to help a youth experiencing a mental health or addictions challenge or crisis. Youth Mental Health First Aid is primarily designed for adults who regularly interact with young people. The course introduces common mental health challenges for youth, reviews typical adolescent development, and teaches a 5-step action plan for how to help young people in both crisis and non-crisis situations. Topics covered include anxiety, depression, substance use, disorders in which psychosis may occur, disruptive behavior disorders (including ADHD), and eating disorders.
