The Coordinator of Mental Health & Social Services and Program Specialist for Strategic Planning & Support Services provided PD focused on SEL to ACE on 8/26/20 and remain available to other schools. The team releases a "Mindful Monday" video every Monday that relates to SEL skill development. Finally, the team is working with the Curriculum & Instruction Department to determine how to best address the overlapping action steps related to culturally responsive instructional practices (meeting 1: 8/31/20; meeting 2: 9/22/20).
