Steps:

1. Follow district Code of Conduct.
2. Document interventions given for all students to decrease OSS.
3. The Principal will work with school-based leadership team, including the AP, school counselor and School Resource Specialist to when looking at behaviors and their consequences
4. The MTSS process will be followed to ensure tiered evidence-based interventions are implemented, monitored and adjusted as needed.
5. The Principal will contact her supervisor if there are any extreme behavior issues that require district level support.

Results of Action Taken:

At this time, there have been 8 ODR's entered among 5 students into the FOCUS system at Citrus Elementary(3AA Ss, 1W, 1Other). There are 2 bus and 6 classroom referrals. There are no other OSSs currently, 35 minor infractions among 4 different students.

Reflection:

We will continue to monitor behavior and utilize the school counselor as needed to work through behaviors with students.
