In September 2022, the School District of Indian River County initiated the implementation of the 2022-2023 African American Achievement Plan. To review and ensure compliance with progress of action steps associated with the African American Achievement Plan, the District provides quarterly updates related to action steps accomplished and quarterly outcomes.

The attached documentation provides school level evidence of progress towards accomplishing action steps incorporated into the 2022-2023 African American Achievement Plan. Documentation requirements have been designed to honor the full intent of the developed African American Achievement Plan while optimizing the efficiency and effectiveness of outlined actionable steps.

To support ongoing accountability of action step implementation, documentation, and progress the following assurances have been verified by the principal/supervisor of each school/location:

- Action steps included within the 2022-2023 African American Achievement Plan have been implemented with consistency and purpose to eliminate the achievement gap.
- Progress related to action steps has been monitored at designated intervals (e.g., monthly, quarterly) outlined in the African American Achievement Plan.
- Data reviews have been conducted to identify areas of strength and concern and disaggregated data will be provided upon request.
- Progress related to the elimination of the achievement gap has been monitored in an ongoing way and needed modifications have been made as identified.

Quarterly Reflection

Hosting the SDIRC School Choice and Community Extravaganza at a more centralized location more than tripled attendance at the event. SDIRC provided transportation shuttle sites at the GYAC and Fellsmere Elementary to provide access to families that may lack transportation. In addition, over 300 students performed and were able to see specific unique program offerings throughout the district.

Opportunities for growth- Ensure title one schools participate in student performance opportunities.

Next steps for work- Ensure SDIRC School Choice and Community Booklets are available both digitally and in print, distributed throughout Indian River County in English and Spanish before the choice window opens November 1st. Continue to promote transportation links for families to see depot access locations for school choice.


